1. Artwork Street Mural Project

The Marquette Sustainability Coalition submitted an art week proposal for a street mural at Third Street and Michigan Street. Kujawa, a member of the group, presented the idea. Paint on the street would act as a visual curb extension of Third Street. Art would also be painted in the middle of the intersections. Street murals have been used in other cities as art projects and have been shown to increase traffic safety where they are implemented as the painted intersections heighten driver's focus.

The committee suggested that any art on the street would not cut into traffic lane widths and advised consulting with the engineering department, the DDA, and the Arts and Culture Office.

Dishno commented that the legality of such a project should be ensured before taking any other steps.
