



MARQUETTE CITY ELECTIONS BOARD
March 24, 2022

A regular meeting of the Marquette City Elections Board was duly called and held on March 24, 2022 at 4:17 p.m. with Board members and Staff meeting in City Hall, Commission Chambers. This meeting was held in order to review and appoint election inspectors for the City's May 3, 2022 Special Election.

Approval of the Agenda

It was moved by Judy Berglund, supported by Barb Hein, and carried unanimously to approve the agenda as presented.

It was moved by Margaret Schwalm, supported by Linda Roe, and carried unanimously to approve the roster of Election Inspectors, including chairs and Receiving Board, and give the City Clerk the ability to appoint additional inspectors, as needed, prior to Election Day.

Appoint AVCB Inspectors for the May 3, 2022 Special Election

It was moved by Judy Berglund, supported by Barb Hein, and carried unanimously to approve the roster of AVCB Inspectors, including chairs and give the City Clerk the ability to appoint additional inspectors, as needed, prior to Election Day.

Update: Review of Election Activities

Clerk Kyle Whitney provided the board with a brief update on the process to prepare for the May Election, which has been called by the Marquette Area Public Schools.
