Approval of the Agenda

It was moved by Sue Menhennick, supported by Linda Roe, and carried unanimously to approve the agenda as presented.

Approval of Minutes

It was moved by Linda Roe, supported by Margaret Schwalm, and carried unanimously to approve the roster of Election Inspectors, including chairs and Receiving Board, and give the City Clerk the ability to appoint additional inspectors, as needed, prior to Election Day.

Appoint AVCB Inspectors for the May 2, 2023 Special Election

It was moved Sue Menhennick, supported by Linda Roe, and carried unanimously to approve the roster of AVCB Inspectors, including chairs and give the City Clerk the ability to appoint additional inspectors, as needed, prior to Election Day.

Update: Review of Election Activities


