



## **MARQUETTE CITY ELECTIONS BOARD**

**April 22, 2021**

A regular meeting of the Marquette City Elections Board was duly called and held on April 22, 2021 at 4:02 p.m. with Board members and Staff participating remotely via Zoom video conferencing. This meeting was held in order to review and verify nominating petitions for local candidates.

**PRESENT:** Judy Berglund, Barb Hein, Linda Roe, Margaret Schwalm, City Clerk Kyle Whitney.

Also present was Deputy City Clerk Rachel Quayle.

### **Approval of the Agenda**

### **Approval of Minutes**

### **Review and Verify Nominating Petitions for Local Candidates**

Three candidates filed for two seats on the Marquette City Commission, while three candidates filed for two seats on the Marquette Board of Light and Power. A primary for local office will only be held if the number of candidates is more than double the number of open seats. All candidates will move automatically to the November 2, 2021 General Election.

Candidates for Marquette City Commission are as follows: Margaret Brumm, Jennifer Hill, and Jennifer Smith.

Candidates for Marquette Board of Light and Power are as follows: John Braamse, John Prince, and Paul Schloegel.

*It was moved by Linda Roe, supported by Judy Berglund, and carried unanimously to verify the candidates for local office.*

**Update Meeting Schedule**

Due to the number of local candidates filing, which did not exceed double the number of open seats, there will be no August primary election. Therefore, it was deemed unnecessary for the Election Board to meet July 8 to appoint August election inspectors and July 20 for the public accuracy test.

**Update: Review of Election Activities**

Clerk Kyle Whitney provided the board with a brief update on postelection audits, conducted by the County and State.

The next scheduled meeting is at 4 p.m. on Thursday, September 23, 2021 at 4 p.m to appoint election inspectors for the November 2, 2021 General Election.
