



MARQUETTE CITY ELECTIONS BOARD
April 22, 2022

A regular meeting of the Marquette City Elections Board was duly called and held on April 22, 2022 at 2:00 p.m. with Board members and Staff meeting in City Hall, Baraga Gym. This meeting was held in order to verify candidates for office and conduct a Public Accuracy test for the City's May 3, 2022 Special Election.

Also present was Deputy City Clerk Rachel Quayle.

Approval of the Agenda

It was moved by Margaret Schwalm, supported by Judy Berglund, and carried unanimously to approve the agenda as presented.

Public Comment

Approval of Minutes

The Board reviewed minutes of the March 24, 2022 meeting.

It was moved by Linda Roe, supported by Margaret Schwalm, and carried unanimously to approve the meeting minutes from the March 24, 2022 Election Board meeting.

Verify Candidates for Local Office

Board members reviewed candidate filing materials. Clerk Whitney explained the local races would only appear on the August primary ballot if the number of candidates is more than twice the number of available seats. Candidates running for the two available seats on the City Commission include, Evan Bonsall, John Frick, Matthew Luttenberger and Sally Davis. There are two candidates running for one seat on the Board of Light Power, Margaret Brumm and Timothy Strom. All candidates for both races automatically move to the November ballot.

It was moved by Judy Berglund, supported by Sue Menhennick, and carried unanimously to verify candidates for local office.

Conduct a Public Accuracy Test for the May 3, 2022 Special Election

The Elections Board conducted a public accuracy test of the May 3, 2022 election material and equipment. Upon completion of the test all materials used were secured and will remain under seal the duration of the retention period.

Update: Review of Election Activities

Clerk Kyle Whitney provided the board with a brief update on the upcoming elections for the remaining 2022 calendar year, which include an August primary election and a November general election.

The next scheduled meeting is Thursday, June 23 to appoint August 2022 election inspectors.
