A regular meeting of the Marquette City Elections Board was duly called and held on June 23, 2022 at 4:00 p.m. with Board members and Staff meeting in City Hall, Commission Chambers. This meeting was held in order to appoint Election Inspectors for the August 2, 2022 State Primary Election.

Appoint AV Counting Board Inspectors for the August 2, 2022, State Primary Election

Board members reviewed the list of qualified election inspectors to work on the Absent Voter Counting Board for the August 2, 2022, State Primary Election. The City Clerk explained the process the AVCB undertakes to tabulate absentee ballots on election day.

It was moved by Sue Menhennick, supported by Margaret Schwalm, and carried unanimously to appoint AV Counting Board inspectors for the August 2, 2022, State Primary Election.

Update: Review of Election Activities

The City Clerk spoke about a security grant. This grant will provide additional recourses to help improve and further secure elections. The City Clerk will be utilizing the grant to purchase new election laptops, a security camera and ballot drop box, and ballot transfer cases.
